Primary Level: Primary 1

Subject and Topic: Numeracy (counting)

Data Handling

pencil

Materials Needed: Worksheet

coloured pencils, markers or crayons for colouring

Objectives:

- pupils can count to the number 6
- pupils can write numbers to 6
- · pupils can identify different objects
- pupils know about nature

Differentiation:

- · Pupils can work independently
- Each array (count 2 objects)
- Pupils can organise volumes of objects
